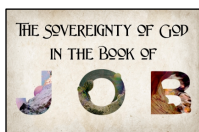

# Reaching the World

## India National Inland Mission– September 18, 2022



India National Inland Mission is one of CBC's longest supported missions. In 1964, Paul and Anne Pillai began ministering in northern India. Their ministry has been filled with persecution and God's supernatural work in advancing the gospel. Their children are continuing this work as both Paul and Anne are now in heaven.

INIM's primary vision remains evangelism and indigenous church planting. This is accomplished through church literature distribution, orphanages, medical and feeding ministries, Christian schools, seminary and a Bible college. Their Bible college graduates minister among the unreached in northern India and other countries where opposition to the gospel is great. Bethesda Children's Home Network rescues destitute and orphaned children physically and spiritually and provides them with formal Christ-centered education.

**Thanking God For-** **1.** Church planters who connect with locals who are cautiously open to the Gospel in rural villages of the Buddhist Kingdom of Bhutan. **2.** The complete provision of school uniforms we desperately needed for the children of Bethesda Children's Home Network. **3.** The 17 young men, former Hindus, Muslims, and one Buddhist who have accepted Christ at our annual local university outreach led by the music team of Grace Bible College. **Prayer For-** **1.** Favor with the Indian Government as we continue waiting for the necessary documents and authorizations to care for the needy. **2.** God's wisdom and discernment for Sujay & Aiko Pillai, Ajay & Heather Pillai as they navigate uncharted waters on the mission field. For Grace Bible College staff & students as we start our 50<sup>th</sup> year of training native missionaries. **3.** Our Lord to raise a new generation of visionary and passionate indigenous missionaries. **4.** That we will accomplish Paul Pillai's Legacy Goal of commissioning and supporting 10,000 indigenous missionaries by 2028 into the largest unreached people groups on earth in South Asia. **5.** The Lord to send 1,000 new mission-minded monthly intercessors & supporters to "Hold the Rope" as we carry the Gospel into the darkness.
