Conditions

- 1. 1 year out of high school by the start of the internship, but 2 years is preferred.
- 2. You will be considered church staff.
- 3. You will receive a stipend of \$200 per week. Housing is available for those who live outside of the area.
- 4. This is a full-time position. There is time off for rest, recreation and personal needs.
- 5. We will debrief the experience at the end of summer
- 6. We see our ministry as a shared ministry with direct responsibility and accountability through Pastor Jason Wood and Director of Children's Ministries, to the Lead Pastor, and the Board.
