 - Come up with creative activities to reinforce the teaching.
 - Get with another staff and go to an office to pray during the worship and teaching.
 - Find someone to pray for. Follow-up with someone you prayed for last week.

Wednesday Night - Airborne

Activities

Worship Music Team

- Help the students in the band gel musically, spiritually, and relationally.
- Get together with students apart from music ministry times to build relationships.
- Help students with the sound board and equipment.
- Dream big of ways to improve this area. (I am really weak here.)

Core Group - Small Groups

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- Small groups for high school ministry
- Lead a FourTwelve group
- Meet with your group once a week
- Do something with your group once every 6-8 weeks outside of FourTwelve group
- Utilize the On Track Devotions or find good material for FourTwelve groups
- Dream of ways FourTwelve groups could improve. example ideas:
- FourTwelve groups structured as freshmen/sophomore and junior/senior
- Leaders stick with an age rather than a group but would be with a class for 2 years
- All groups doing the same thing
- Mix up guys and girls for a bible study format and less of the sharing format

Media and Other Visual Ministry

- Serve once a month or bi-monthly at Wednesday night youth group during the school year (mid-August through May)
- Purchase food but get reimbursed
- Prepare meal
- Clean the kitchen
